



Moatsu Festival Tour – 13 days

Naga culture, tea plantations and wildlife

Tour JTT-ASNA-02: Dimapur – Kohima – Tuophema – Mokokchung – Jorhat – Majuli - Kaziranga

Fixed dates: April 28 – May 10, 2018

Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Dimapur – Kohima (74 km/ 2 hrs)

Arrive Dimapur, transfer to Kohima, PM visit the Second World War memorial and the very interesting local market. Overnight at the Japfu hotel.

Day 02: Kohima

Morning visit Khonoma village, 20 km one way. Afternoon drive short distance to the southern Angami tribal village of Kigwema.



Day 03: Kohima – Tuophema (45 km/ 1 ½ hrs)

Drive to Tuophema, 45 km/ 1 and ½ hour. Check into Village resort built in the Angami Naga style with amenities for a comfortable stay. Walk in the old village and visit the small but interesting museum. Evening enjoy a traditional dance performance by the local people.

Day 04: Tuophema

Morning drive short distance to a village inhabited by the Rengma Naga tribe. You can have a look at the traditional weaving in some households and also buy Naga shawls or stoles, if interested, direct from the villagers. Afternoon at Tuophema.

Day 05: Tuophema – Mokokchung (115 km/ 4 hrs)

Drive to Mokokchung and check into Tourist Lodge. Today the whole place is agog with the festival MOATSU of the Ao tribe residing in Mokokchung. Afternoon visit the local ground where the festivities are being held.

MOATSU is celebrated right after the fields have been ploughed and the new crop planted, to pray to the almighty that the crop will not fail and there will be plenty for the village.



Day 06: Mokokchung

In Mokokchung visiting Longkhum and Ungma villages and coming back to the local ground for the festival.

Day 07: Mokokchung

Another day at the festival – in and around Mokokchung.



Day 08: Mokokchung – Jorhat (103 km/ 3 hrs)

Drive to Jorhat in Assam. Check into Sangsua tea bungalow. Afternoon tea tour visiting tea plantation and factory (factory not in operation from mid December to end March)

Day 09: Ferry across River Brahmaputra – Majuli Island

Drive 45 km to Neematighat near the town of Jorhat, take a ferry across the mighty Brahmaputra to Majuli Island, the culture center of Assam. Visit Hindu monasteries or 'satras'. Interact with the 'bhakats' or monks, know about their practices and way of living. Overnight at Mishing Cottages.

Day 10: Majuli Island – Kaziranga National Park (2 hrs ferry, drive 120 km/ 3 hrs)

Take the return ferry to Neematighat and drive on to Kaziranga National Park for overnight stay. Check into Iora – The retreat or similar. Afternoon jeep safari in the western range of the park.

Day 11: Kaziranga

Early morning elephant safari in the central range of the park. Afternoon jeep safari in the central range of the park. Apart from 2200 rhino's roaming the park Kaziranga is also well known for its bird life with almost 500 species recorded. Wild buffalos, deer,

elephants make this park a favorite for the wild life enthusiast. Overnight at Iora Retreat or similar.

Day 12: Kaziranga – Guwahati (220 km/ 5 hrs)

Drive to Guwahati, check into Hotel Kironshree Portico or similar. Afternoon visit Kalakshetra, a sprawling enclosure depicting cultures and traditions of Northeast India with an interesting museum. Evening a one hour cruise on the River Brahmaputra.



Day 13: Guwahati Airport

Transfer to Guwahati airport for outbound flight.
